




# tracking-column

## Description

Describes a column of data in a [tracking-table](#).

This macro *must* be placed within a [tracking-table](#) macro.

## Parameters

Name	Required	Available In	Default Value	Description
value				<p>The value to report. May be one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>id</b> - The ID of the content.</li><li>• <b>title</b> - The title of the content.</li><li>• <b>space key</b> - The space key.</li><li>• <b>space name</b> - The space name.</li><li>• <b>creation date</b> - The date the content was created.</li><li>• <b>modification date</b> - The date the content was last modified.</li><li>• <b>first view date</b> - The date the content was first viewed by someone other than the creator.</li><li>• <b>last view date</b> - The date the content was last viewed by someone other than the last editor.</li><li>• <b>view count</b> - The number of times the content has been viewed since the firstViewed date.</li><li>• <b>age in days</b> - The number of days between the day the content was created and now.</li><li>• <b>views per day</b> - The average number of views per day since the content was created.</li></ul>
displayFormat				<p>For values returning a date, the date format (e.g. 'dd-MMM-yyyy').</p> <p>May also be 'long', 'medium' or 'short', which will use the system defaults for those formats.</p>
title				<p>Provides an alternate title for the column. Defaults to the 'value' type.</p>
